The next WEDNESDAY FELLOWSHIP will be on 20th January and meets in St Mary's Church Room at 8pm.

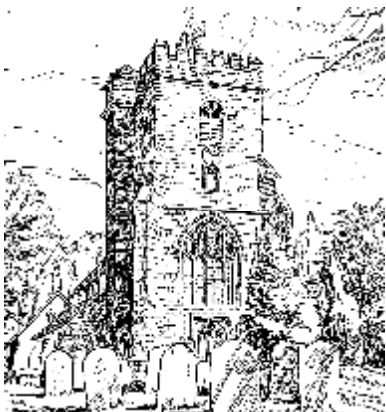
